6. General advice

a. pinching : 3-5 weeks after emergence (to get 4-6 stems per plant)

b. support : netting is not necessary.

c. harvest stage : when the first plume has opened for 30-40%. Flower length

will then be approx. 5 cm. When harvested too soon, the

flowers tend to warp (bend).

d. harvest period : first cutting will be approx. 14-16 weeks after sowing.

Harvest period is 6-8 weeks. After this the plants can be cut

back for a second harvest.

d. general : Disbudding helps to promote side-branching.

The colour is influenced by temperature. The cooler the pight, the brighter rose the colour will be
